#### Day 1 - Wednesday, June 12 - Departure from USA

Day 2 - Thursday, June 13 - Morning arrival, Warsaw

- Arrive Warsaw & transfer to hotel
- Tour St. Stanislaw Kostka; Church of Fr. Jerzy Popieluszko
- Mass at convent of St. Faustina
- Welcome dinner

Day 3 - Friday, June 14 Niepokalanow, Czestochowa

- After breakfast depart for a full day at Niepokalanow, the City of the Immaculate Mother of God, founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe
- Lunch at the monastery
- Mass
- Group dinner

Day 4 - Saturday, June 15 Czestochowa

- After breakfast depart for Czestochowa for overnight stay
- Guided tour of Jasna Gora
- Lunch on your own
- Mass at Shrine to Our Lady of Czestochowa
- Group dinner

Day 5 - Sunday, June 16, Auschwitz and Krakow

- After breakfast, check out
- Mass at Czestochowa
- Depart for Auschwitz.
- Guided Tour and visit chapel where St. Maximilian Kolbe sacrificed his life.
- Group lunch in local restaurant
- Late afternoon check in at hotel in Krakow
- -Group dinner

Day 6 - Monday, June 17, Divine Mercy Day - St. Faustina in Lagiewniki

- After breakfast, drive to Shrine of Divine Mercy
- Mass, reconciliation and a talk by one of the Sisters of Mercy
- Holy Hour and Chaplet of Divine Mercy in the chapel where the relics of St. Faustina are present.
- Lunch and Dinner on your own

Day 7 - Tuesday, June 18, St. John Paul II Day - Krakow

- After breakfast, St. Stanislaus Kostka Church in Debniki
- Visit the burial place of Jan Tyranowski
- Entire day will be spent visiting places connected to the life and ministry of St. John Paul II.
- Mass at St. Mary's
- Lunch and Dinner on your own

Day 8 - Wednesday, June 19 - Krakow

- After breakfast, we tour the Wawel Cathedral and complex surrounding.
- Afternoon on your own to explore Krakow.
- Lunch and Dinner on your own

Day 9 - Thursday, June 20 - Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, Wadowice

- After breakfast we depart for the sanctuary of Kalwaria Zebrzydowska
- Mass in the beautiful Bernardine Monastery
- Group lunch
- Visit the Wieliczka Salt Mines with local guide
- Farewell Group Dinner with Polish dancing

Day 10 - Friday, June 21 Depart Krakow

- Breakfast & check out
- Mass
- Transfer to airport to return to USA
- \*Breakfast included daily
- \*Group lunches and dinners are noted, all other meals are on your own. (total of 3 group lunches, 5 group dinners)

\$5550<sup>00</sup> per person (double occupancy) includes: Economy International group airfare ONLY from/to Chicago (you are responsible for the domestic flight to/from Chicago); 8 nights in 4\* hotels & hotel porterage; continental breakfast daily; 5 dinners; 3 lunches; group airport transfers in Poland; all tours and entrance fees (as noted in the itinerary); English speaking escort throughout trip; gratuities for meals, guides, and bus drivers; and all taxes. Responsibility: The tour member understands that he or she has no claim against Holy Family Travel, Inc., DBA Trinity Travel, (hereinafter "Trinity Travel") its principals, employees, representatives, or its affiliates for events or circumstances beyond their control, including, without limitation, any delay or cancellation in transportation; change of transportation equipment; or for delay or damage to or loss of property or baggage or injury to or death of persons due to any neglect or willful act of an air carrier, hotel, bus company, steamship or cruise company, railroad, transportation company or service company of any kind, or any other person or persons rendering any of the services being offered in connections with these tours. Further, Trinity Travel advises that it has no ownership interest whatsoever in any hotel, restaurant, bus company or transportation or service company of any kind, nor does it have any employee outside of the USA. You may see the name Trinity Travel affixed to motor vehicles, on signs around the hotel or elsewhere. This use of our name is purely for reasons of identification and does not denote ownership, supervision, or control by Trinity Travel in any way. Trinity Travel acts only as an agent in securing hotels, transportation, and other travel services from suppliers, and in no event shall Trinity Travel be liable in the event of any failure by any person or company to render any transportation, lodging or other travel services to be provided on the tour. If there is a difference between the conditions of Trinity Travel and those published by suppliers, the conditions of suppliers shall apply. Trinity Travel and its overseas representatives reserves the right to change, amend or cancel any part or all the tour; substitute hotels, cruise ships and air carriers of similar quality; and to vary the sequence of sightseeing and/ or to re-route the order of cities; make such other changes as may be reasonably necessary. Trinity Travel may correct pricing errors at any time or increase the program price in the event of increases due to change in fuel surcharges, currency fluctuations, entrance fees or taxes. In calculating the cost of the trip, Trinity Travel has relied on your consent to these terms and in the absence of this release, the cost of the trip would be higher. A contract is made, and these terms are deemed accepted by the tour member when your reservation and initial payment are accepted by Trinity Travel. Any dispute regarding these terms or any other matter related to the services provided by Trinity Travel shall be governed by Kansas law and settled by binding arbitration in Overland Park, KS. We reserve the right to decline to accept a person, or to remove a person from a tour, if such person presents a significant risk to the health or safety of himself or the group and the person cannot otherwise be reasonably accommodated.

Flights: If group airfare is not offered, each traveler will be provided with the School of Faith staff flight itinerary. Group transportation to and from the airport will be based on that itinerary. Travelers are responsible or meeting the group at a specified time and location on arrival day. If their schedule does not closely coordinate with the group schedule, travelers will be responsible for the cost of transfers to and from the airport. Travelers must provide Trinity Travel no less than 60 days before departure with their purchased flight itinerary. DO NOT PURCHASE INDEPENDENT AIRLINE TICKETS UNTIL NOTIFIED IN WRITING THAT THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF TRAVELERS HAS BEEN MET TO OPERATE THE TRIP. Travelers are responsible for complying with all airline requirements for checked and carry-on baggage.

**Health Requirements:** Travelers should be medically and physically fit for this pilgrimage. The pilgrimage requires moderate walking, sometimes over uneven surfaces. Motor coaches are not always able to drop off passengers close to the site entrances. Some sites involve stairs and sites are not always wheelchair accessible. Please discuss any existing medical condition prior to booking your reservation.

**Photography:** Trinity Travel may take photographs of its trips and travelers, and traveler grants express permission to do so and to use such photographs for promotional purposes without compensation to traveler.

**Identification Required:** A passport is required for all travelers, and it should be valid for at least 6 months past the scheduled return date. Non-U.S. citizens may require a visa prior to departure. The cost of passports and any required visa is the responsibility of the traveler.

Cancellation Policy and Refunds: We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your Trinity Travel pilgrimage: however, should you need to cancel, your cancellation must be received in writing, via email, fax or by letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation charges per person will apply date of deposit until final payment due date – 50% of deposit amount; after the final payment due date – NO REFUND. Once the tour commences there will be no refunds for missed or unused portions of the tour program. The purchase of travel insurance is strongly recommended.
