Savior Pastoral Center Guidelines

Please keep these guidelines in mind during a stay at Savior Pastoral Center (SPC):

- Snacks, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages may be brought on site. We ask the alcoholic beverages are not kept in the common area. Please label all items with your name if you wish to keep them in the common area refrigerator.
- Feel free to socialize in the Strecker Suites common area at the end of a day, but please be considerate of those that retire to their room early.
- **The doors to SPC are locked 24 hours a day. Upon check-in, you will receive a key card to access the building. We'll have the doors open for commuters in the morning. The front desk will let you in during the day.**

- Please be aware that there are no phones in the guest rooms and there are no pay phones located on the premises. Cell phones are welcome.
- Animals are not allowed on the premises.
